





The Social Licence to Operate


- "addressing the demands and expectations that emerge from neighbourhoods, environmental groups, community members, and other elements of the surrounding civil society"

SLO- a complex issue


- Context-specific

Limitations of conventional management


- Avoidance
 - No basis for problem-solving
 - Encourages rumour
 - Seems short-termist
 - Lack of positive social impact
- Formal
 - Assumes legitimacy of processes
